This study explored Greek and Russian EFL university students' awareness and attitudes towards the use of electronic portfolios as a form of online formative assessment to monitor the process and progress of foreign language learning. To that end, data was collected by 190 participants via an online questionnaire. Based on the findings obtained, some practical suggestions are offered.
